Objectives and activities of the promoter

The Association for the vocational, integral and social training of the people – Inserta Andalucía - is a non-profit-organization that arises in the year 2008 to give response to the needs of orientation, occupational and social insertion of groups with disadvantages for example: ethnic, immigrant minorities and people in risk of social exclusion. The instrument used to get this general objective is principally not formal education and work orientation.

The objectives of our Association are:

- 1) To promote the personal, social and work development of the young people in risk of social exclusion.*
- 2) To increase the employability, autonomy and independence of the young people.*
- 3) Provides work orientation to young people belonging to vulnerable groups to get social inclusion and labor insertion.*
- 4) To promote the Vocational training as alternative to the traditional formation.*



- 5) *To promote the entrepreneurship and to encourage the young people towards the self-employment as alternative to find a job.*
- 6) *To manage a residential minor`s protection center where we work labor insertion of them.*

To achieve the above objectives we promote a wide range of activities. We develop these by ourselves or in consortium or agreement with other Public or private Entities (Caixa, Junta de Andalucía or other NGO).

Some of the programs we work on are:

- *Center of Orientation and Insertion labor "Fernando de los Ríos".*
- *Social Mentoring program, it is a volunteer program.*
- *Occupational Mentoring program, it is a volunteer program.*
- *Family skills are worked with groups at risk of social exclusion in collaboration with community social services.*
- *Formative program of Orientation and Insertion occupational for young people in risk of social exclusion.*
- *Emancipation Program is a program to follow up previously supervised guys until the 25 years old.*
- *Development of the Master in intervention and emancipation of young people in conflict with the University of Almeria.*

What are the skills and expertise of key staff/persons involved in this application?

The people who belong to our association work with the objective of increasing the opportunities, competences and promote the labor insertion and autonomy of the young people that we serve. We are convinced that non-formal education is the most effective vehicle for acquiring tools, knowledge, skills ... and therefore it guides much of our work. We have a wide experience working with disadvantaged groups and we love our work, we want our young people to have the greatest number of resources and opportunities to grow: socially, personally and laboriously.

I'll detail our personal experience a little more:

Director: *Degree in Law, complementary formation in management of human resources, prevention of labor risks, international migrations and aliens. Skills to coordinate and to work team.*

Coordinator: *Graduated in Social Work and Immigration. Great capacity of coordination and management.*

Two Educators: *Degrees in psychology psych pedagogical adaptation, conflict prevention and resolution in the residential area, gender violence and drug dependence prevention. Empathy and skills for the treatment, communication and active listening. Formative capacity for support in interpersonal, emotional and communicative processes.*

Two Technicians in Labor Integration: *Graduated in Social work and technical superior in Sociocultural Animation. Ability to advise, guide and train in labor matters through orientation workshops and social work insertion to young people in social exclusion.*

Assistant Educational Technician: Bachelor of Science in Physical Activity and Sport. Capacity for educational intervention with young people through physical and sports activities.

Social Worker: Degree in Social Work. Ability to detect and diagnose needs and critical situations. Ability to establish networks of coordination and collaboration with socio-economic resources for young people

European project department: It consists of two people one of these is Sociologist, with experience in the development and coordination of educational, social and cultural activities in an European level the other is a Student of the double degree of Law-Business Administration with great experience in the associative world and social participation.
